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Document Accessibility

- HTML
- Microsoft Word or Microsoft PowerPoint
- Other Word Processing or Slide Deck Software or Applications
 - Google Docs or Google Slides
 - Mac Keynote and Pages
- PDF



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Why Use Headings

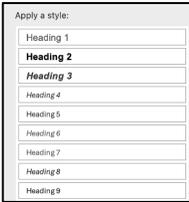
- Headings provide structure and accessibility.
- Headings give you more control over your style.
- Using headings allows you to easily create a table of contents.



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More About Headings

- Applying formatting to normal text does not create a true heading.
- Available headings in the style menu are Heading 1 through Heading 9.
- Document title is Heading 1 (not Title).
- Do not use Headings for other text that is not a heading.

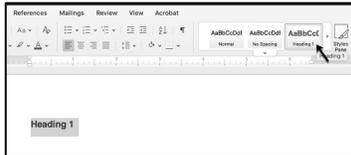


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How to Add Headings

- Highlight the text
- Click on the appropriate heading
- Or use keyboard shortcuts
 - PC: Control+Alt+1
 - Mac: Command+Option+1

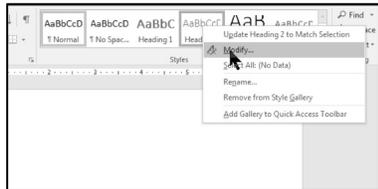


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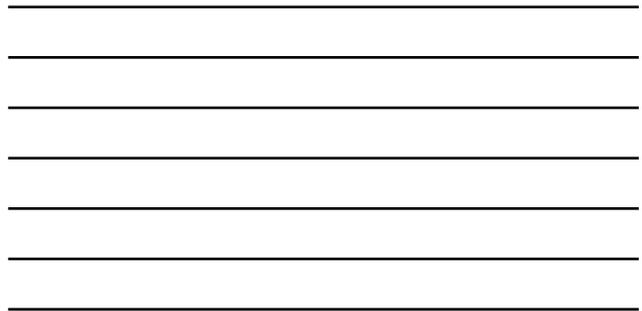


Modify Headings

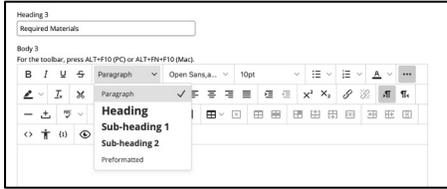
- Right click on the heading in the styles group and choosing **Modify**
- OR
- Change the heading in your document and choose **Update Heading to Match Selection**



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Headings in Blackboard



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Alt Text

a text description of an image (or other non-text content)

**Also called:
alternative text, image description**



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Why Use Alt Text

- Without alt text, a screen reader user will not know what an image is.
- Images often convey important information.
- The screen reader will just say "graphic"



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Sample Alt Text

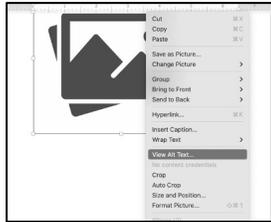
A Pomeranian wearing glasses looks down at an open book.



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How to Add Alt Text

- Right click on the image
- Choose Edit Alt Text
- Write the description in the box that appears to the right of the document.
- Describe what is in the image.
- No need to say "image of" or "picture of"



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Purely Decorative Image

- If an image is purely decorative, mark as decorative
- Images that do not add anything to the content
- Images that are redundant to the content
- Images that are visual separators



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Example: Adding Alt Text



- This slide is intentionally missing alt text. Image is a pileated woodpecker.



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More Complex Images

- For charts and graphs, make sure to select the outside edge when adding alt text
- Option 1: Place full description in alt text
- Option 2: Include brief description and summarize the rest of the data in the slide content



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Chart Sample

- 45% have 6 to 10 errors on page
- 30% have more than 10 errors on page
- 20% have 3 to 5 errors on page
- 5% have fewer than 2 errors on page.

- Captions should have punctuation
- Captions should provide information about what is happening auditorily in addition to spoken words.
- Automation has its place and its limits.

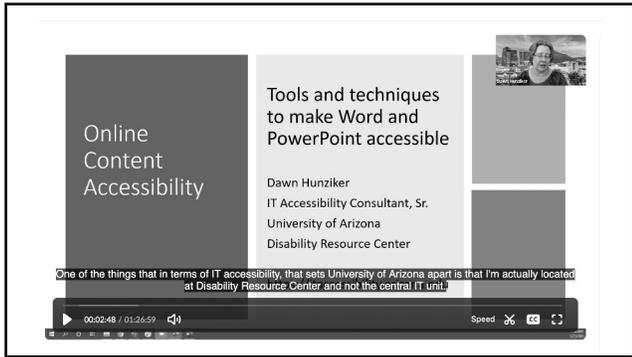
